

SIN'24 Call for Workshop, Special Session and Tutorial Proposals

The 17th International Conference on Security of Information and Networks (SIN'2024) is technically sponsored by IEEE and will be held in Sydney, Australia, December 2-4, 2024. SIN'24 invites proposals for in-person, on-site workshops, tutorials and special sessions addressing all aspects and issues of security in information and Networks to be held at conference. The conference provides an excellent international forum for sharing knowledge and results in theory, methodology, and applications of Security in information and networks.

Proposals of at most 4 pages should be submitted by e-mail to the Conference General Chair at <u>sinconf@sinconf.org</u>. Proposals should provide:

- a. A title and a brief description of the topic and content.
- b. Estimate of number of attendees.
- c. For workshops; if the workshop was held before, please provide a note specifying where the workshop was held and how many papers were accepted.

If accepted, proposers will be responsible for sourcing papers and presenters for their session. All papers for special sessions and workshops are expected to be of better quality than general papers, must be submitted via EDAS, and will be reviewed for inclusion in the official IEEE Xplore conference publication.
